

# DIATOMACHEOUS EARTH SUGGESTED DOSAGES

## SMALL ANIMALS

Give once a day:

- Cats - 1/2 teaspoon
- Kittens - 1/4 teaspoon
- Large Dogs - 1 teaspoon
- Small Dogs - 1/2 teaspoon
- Mini dogs - 1/4 teaspoon
  
- Chickens - 1/2 teaspoon. (Also spread in the pen for odor control.)
- Rabbits - 1/2 teaspoon. (Also spread in the pen for odor control.)
- Hamsters - 1/4 teaspoon. (Also spread in the pen for odor control.)

## LARGE ANIMALS

Use food grade diatomaceous earth mixed with grains, not to exceed a ratio of 2%, as an anti caking agent. DE helps eliminate ants, aphids, flea beetles, fleas, earwigs, sow bugs, mites, bed bugs, etc.

Diatomaceous earth works great for de-worming and parasite removal for all animals, humans, livestock, and all pets. Our combination Diatomaceous Earth and Calcium Bentonite helps bind micro-toxins. Add our food grade diatomaceous earth to livestock water to help prevent algae.

Recommend giving once a day:

- Horses - 1000 lbs. or less = one scoop. (one scoop = 1 tablespoon)
- Horses - 1000 lbs Plus = one and 1/2 scoops.
- Horses - large draft horses = 2 to 3 scoops.
- Cattle, Dairy Cows, & Hogs - 2% of dry feed ration (2# DE per 100# feed.)
- Goats & Sheep - 2% in grain (1 teaspoon per 150 lbs.)
- Alpacas and Llamas - 2% in feed. (1 teaspoon per 150 lbs.)
